Rachel Kim Kurt

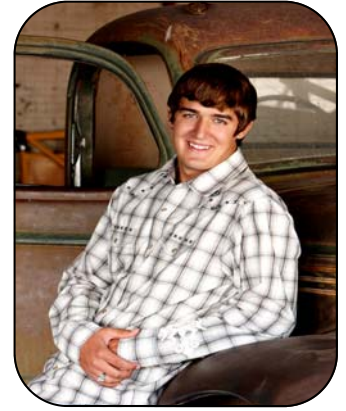
Co-Valedictorian, NHS President, Top 10% of Class

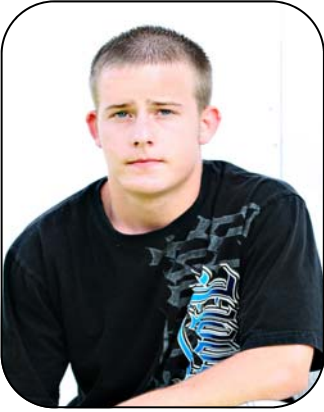
Andrea Quijano Alvarez

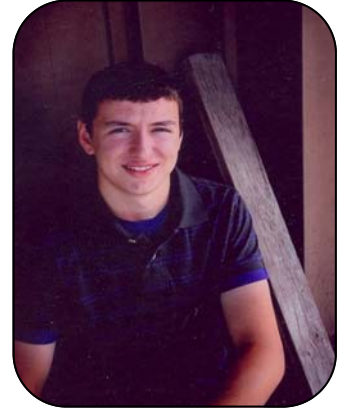

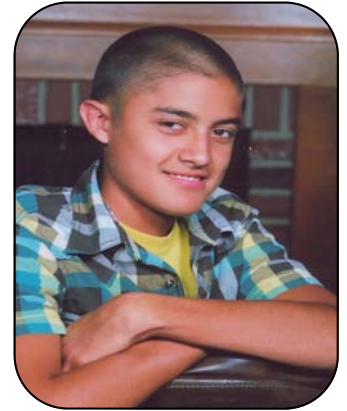

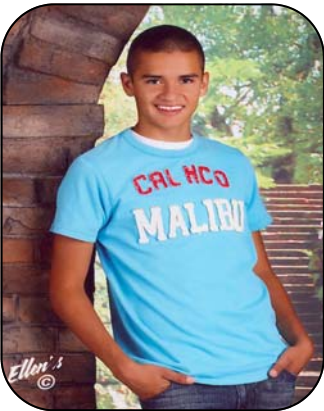
Heber Jimenez NHS

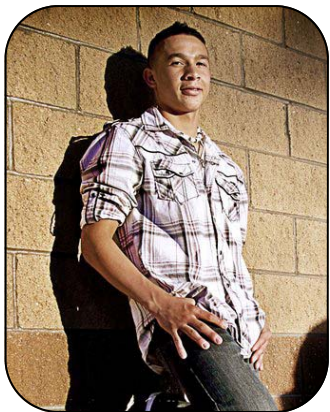

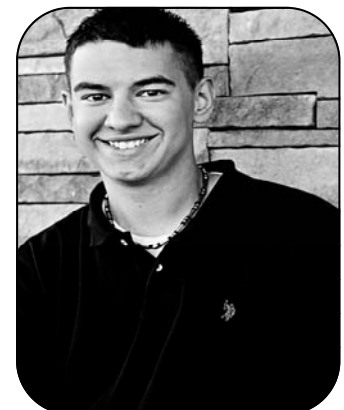

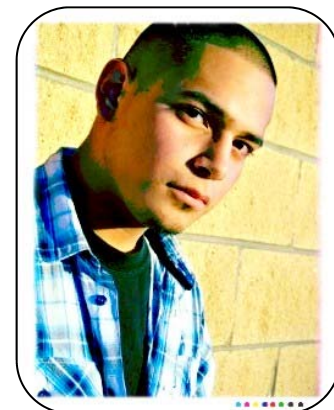
Dario Alejandro Salcedo

Trae N. Stelzer

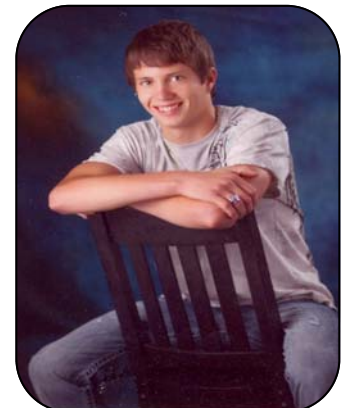
